We write in response to your June 12, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response.

Hello, I wonder if you could help me? We are looking for a copy of the list of "scrutinized companies" that RI Statutes Chapter 35-10.3-4 required to be compiled for divestment in companies that deal with Iran.

I wonder if you or your office can provide us with a copy of the list.

We are unable to provide you with the requested document as the information it contains is considered proprietary and precluded from disclosure pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-2(A)(II)(B). If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Jeffrey M. Padwa, General Counsel for the Rhode Island General Treasurer's Office, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
