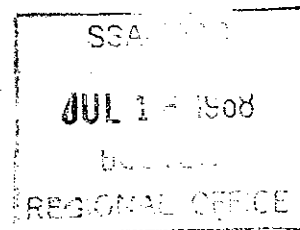
SUBJECT: Modification No. 76 to the Federal-State Agreement and

## TO RHODE ISLAND STATE SOCIAL SECURITY AGREEMENT
