SUBJECT: State and Local Coverage - Rhode Island Modification No. 59

COMMENTS: Cleared for approval.

The Exeter-West Greenwich Regional School District established pursuant to Chapter 80 of the 1965 January Session of the legislature is governed by the regional district school committee, the members of which are elected biennially from the constituent towns. Section I(F) confers on the regional district school committee all powers provided for in section 16-3-11 of the General Laws (as amended in 1958). The last mentioned provision states that regional districts established pursuant thereto shall be bodies corporate and politic and that the school committees shall have extensive powers including the power to sue, be sued, contract, and issue bonds and to acquire, hold, and dispose of property, both real and personal. The regional school district financial meeting is authorized to approve the issuance of bonds and to require payment by each constituent town of its proportionate share of the district's yearly construction and operating costs. It is clear, therefore, that the district under consideration is a separate political subdivision within the meaning of the Act. See also: Modification No. 37. Housing Authorities have been covered on a number of previous occasions commencing with Modification No. 21.
