

TO STATE OF RHODE ISLAND STATE SOCIAL SECURITY AGREEMENT

Whereas, the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare and the State of Rhode Island, acting through its representative designated to administer its responsibilities entered into an agreement on 12/20/51 for the purpose of extending coverage under the provisions of the Social Security Act, as amended, to the employees of the State and the political subdivisions of the State; and

Whereas, the State of Rhode Island had extended coverage effective 3/31, 1951, under Section 218 to the services of the employees of the Town of Warren Housing Authority in all coverage groups (as defined in Section 218(b)(5) of the Act) by means of the original State-Federal Agreement; and

Whereas, The Town of Warren filed wage reports and made payments of contributions for the employees of the Town of Warren Housing Authority, a separate political subdivision, under the name and identification number of the Town of Warren for periods after 3/31/73, in the belief that such action would result in coverage for employees of the Town of Warren Housing Authority under the provisions of the Social Security Act, as amended; and

Whereas, the filing of such wage reports and contribution returns was erroneous;

Now, Therefore, the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare and the State of Rhode Island, acting through its representative designated to administer its responsibilities under the above agreement, hereby agree to and by this modification do correct the error to which reference is made above by extending coverage under Section 218 to the services of the Town of Warren Housing Authority, a political subdivision of the State of Rhode Island, in all coverage groups (as defined in Section 218(b)(5) of the Act) with coverage effective as of 3/31/73, beginning of the period for which wage reports were first erroneously filed



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

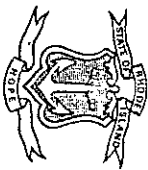
