"The Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare and the State of Rhode Island, acting through its representative designated to administer its responsibilities under the agreement of December 20, 1951, hereby accept the following amendment (s) to such agreement:

"Part B of said agreement ('Services Covered') is amended to add the following new paragraph (after the last paragraph listing of mandatory exclusions).

"Services performed by an individual as an employee serving on a temporary basis in case of fire, storm, snow, earthquake, flood, or other similar emergency."


