We write in response to your June 16, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response:

*Please forward me electronic copies of the following documents:*

*1) Your testimony and all related supporting documents you presented at the June 1<sup>st</sup> Senate Finance Committee and June 3<sup>rd</sup> House Finance Committee hearings on the pension settlement.*

*2) The March 2015 "Actuarial Analysis of the Settlement Proposal" prepared by actuaries Gabriel Roeder Smith. I am requesting the full actuarial analysis itself and not the 3-page summary letter dated March 13, 2015 the actuaries sent to you and General Treasurer Magaziner which is already in my possession.*

*3) February 2014 "Actuarial Analysis of the Proposed Settlement Agreement" prepared by actuaries Gabriel Roeder Smith. I am requesting the full actuarial analysis itself and not the 14-page summary letter dated February 10, 2014 the actuaries sent to you and Director of Administration Licht which is already in my possession.*


Enclosed please find documents responsive to your requests Nos. 1 and 2. There are no responsive documents in addition to what you have already identified in Request No. 3.

If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Jeffrey M. Padwa, General Counsel for the Rhode Island General Treasurer's Office, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
