We write in response to your September 2, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response:

I'm requesting Rhode Island's 2015 list of scrutinized companies found to be engaging in investment activities in Iran, pursuant to Rhode Island General Law section 37-2.5-2(b). I'm a couple of weeks early from exactly one year since we last corresponded but I figured I'd get my request in early in case the state has the list ready. I've attached the 2014 list for reference.

There are no documents responsive to your request. If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Jeffrey M. Padwa, General Counsel for the Rhode Island General Treasurer's Office, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
