I am requesting a copy of the contract ESRI or Rhode Island utilized to develop its pension administration software system. If RI's pension administration system is operated or maintained with in-state personnel, I would be interested in securing whatever contract led to the development of the legacy system currently in place.

Enclosed please find a document responsive to your request. Please be advised that the fully executed contract is in storage. It is estimated that search and retrieval of the fully executed contract could take more than one hour and pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-4 the cost for such a search and retrieval is \$15.00 per hour (with the first hour free). Kindly note that we believe this request has been fulfilled, unless and until you direct us to undertake such a search and retrieval.

If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to RIGL §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Frank J. Karpinski, Executive Director of the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
