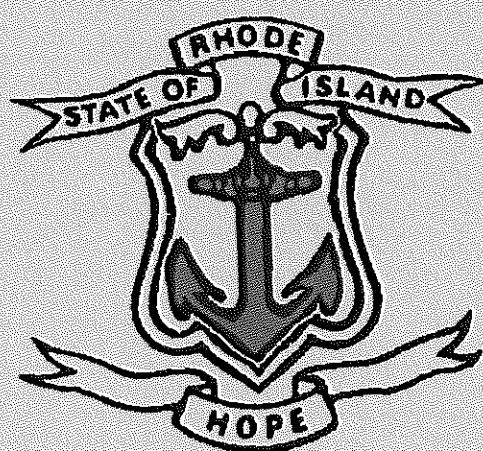

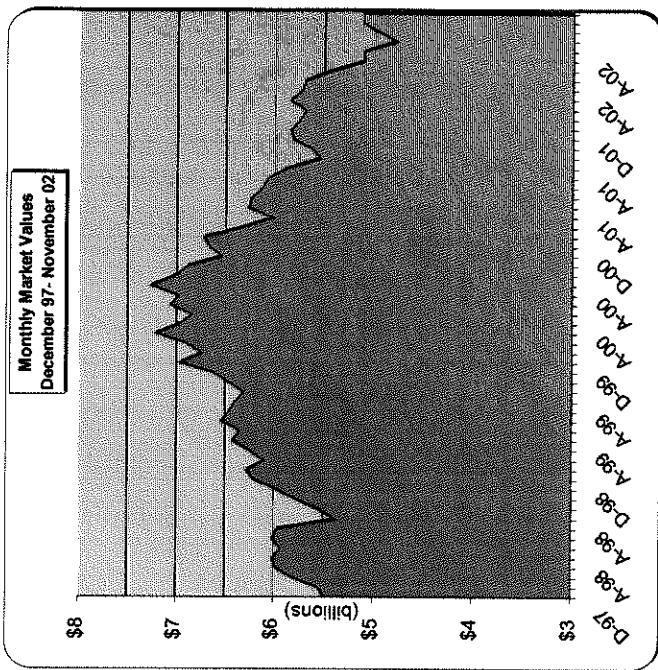

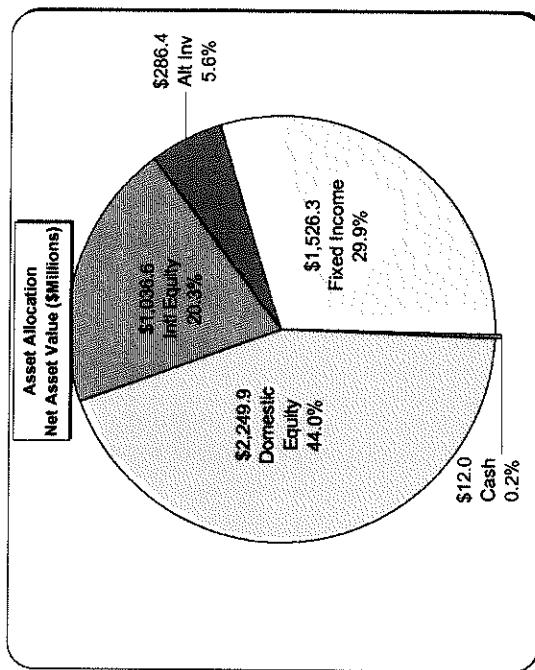
### Market Values

The total portfolio value increased in November by \$164 million, including transfers, to \$5,111 billion. This compares with a increase in value of \$185 million for the same period in 2001. The domestic equity market values increased by \$127 million during the month of November; fixed income decreased by \$14 million, including transfers, while international equity values were up by \$45 million. Alternative investments decreased in value by \$866,000, while the cash accounts were up by \$6 million.



### Asset Allocation

The domestic equities portfolio is under-allocated by 1.0%. The fixed income portfolio is over-allocated by 2.4%. The international equity portfolio is over-allocated by 0.3%, while the alternative investment assets are under-allocated by 1.9%



## **Manager Funding**

A summary of cash transfers by asset class which took place during November is presented at right. Such transfers are required to provide sufficient cash for alternative investment funding as well as to meet current retirement payroll obligations (\$12.2 MM).

### **Cash Flow**

November's pension payroll of \$39.7 million exceeded the \$31.7 million in contributions received by \$8 million. To meet this shortfall and other obligations, \$12.2 million was transferred from long term investments.

### **Alternative Investments**

At this time the alternative investment asset class has unfunded commitments of approximately \$347.7 million, on commitments of \$656 million.

### **Expenses**

Expenses accrued during November totalled \$477,843 was comprised of private equity fees and other professional management fees.

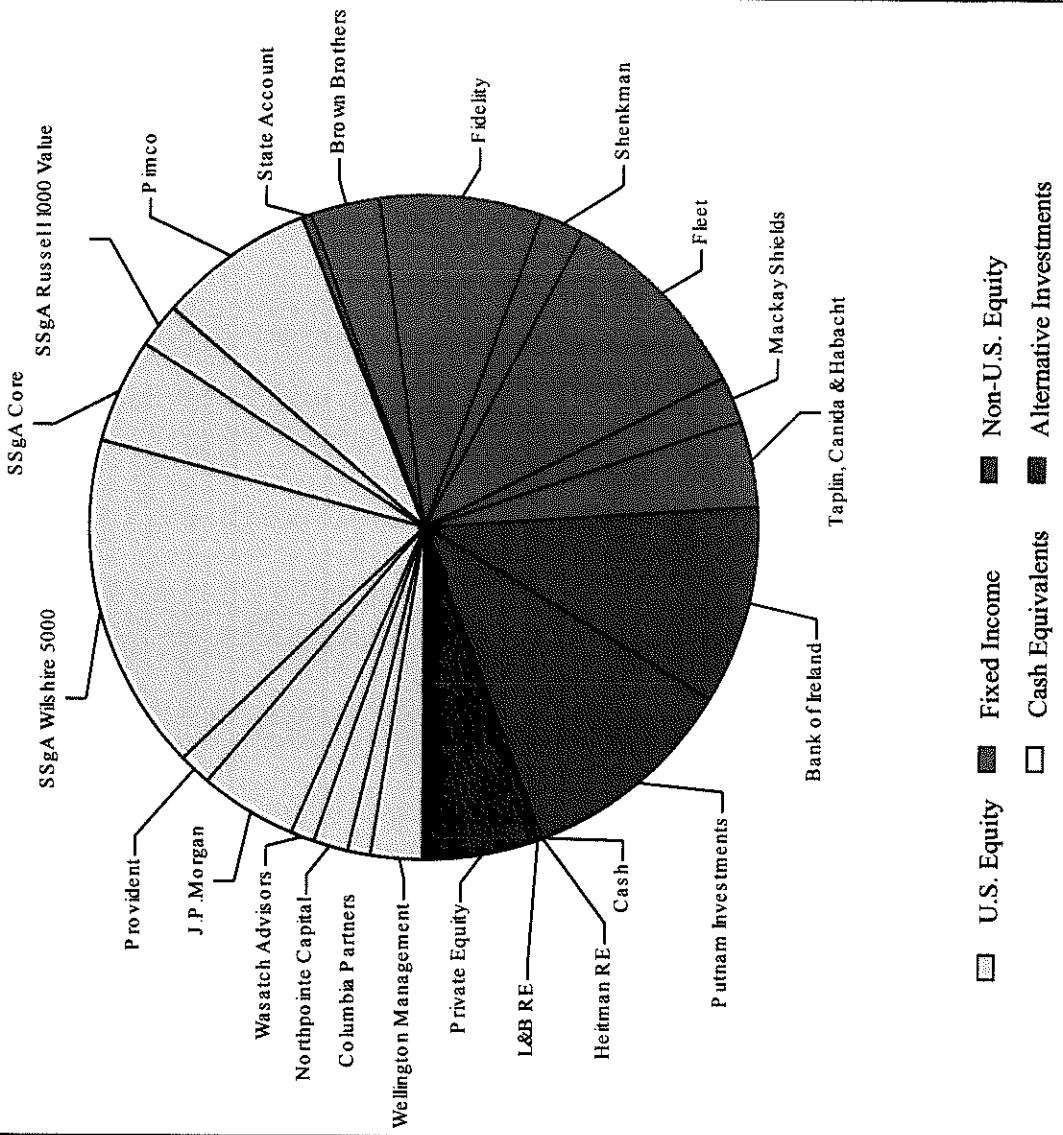
The short term cash portfolio had a 38 day weighted average maturity vs 36 days in October, and 5 days in November of 2001. The length in maturity is due primarily to the FY04 tobacco funds being invested thru July of next year. Investments at November 30th totaled \$324.8 million. Interest earned during the month was \$131,792 of which \$17,133 was credited to the retirement accounts. The average investment rate of 1.27% was 3 basis points above the average 30 day treasury rate.

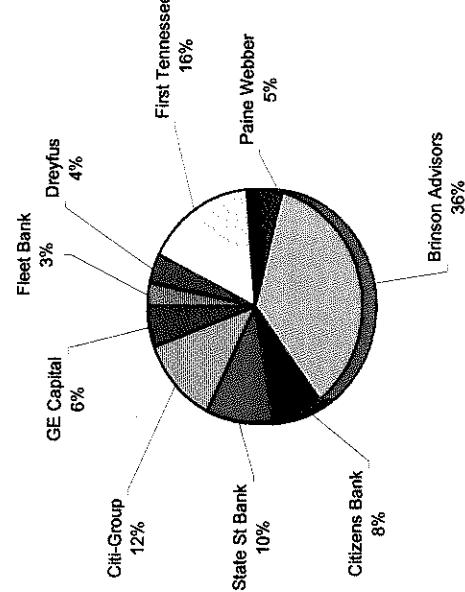

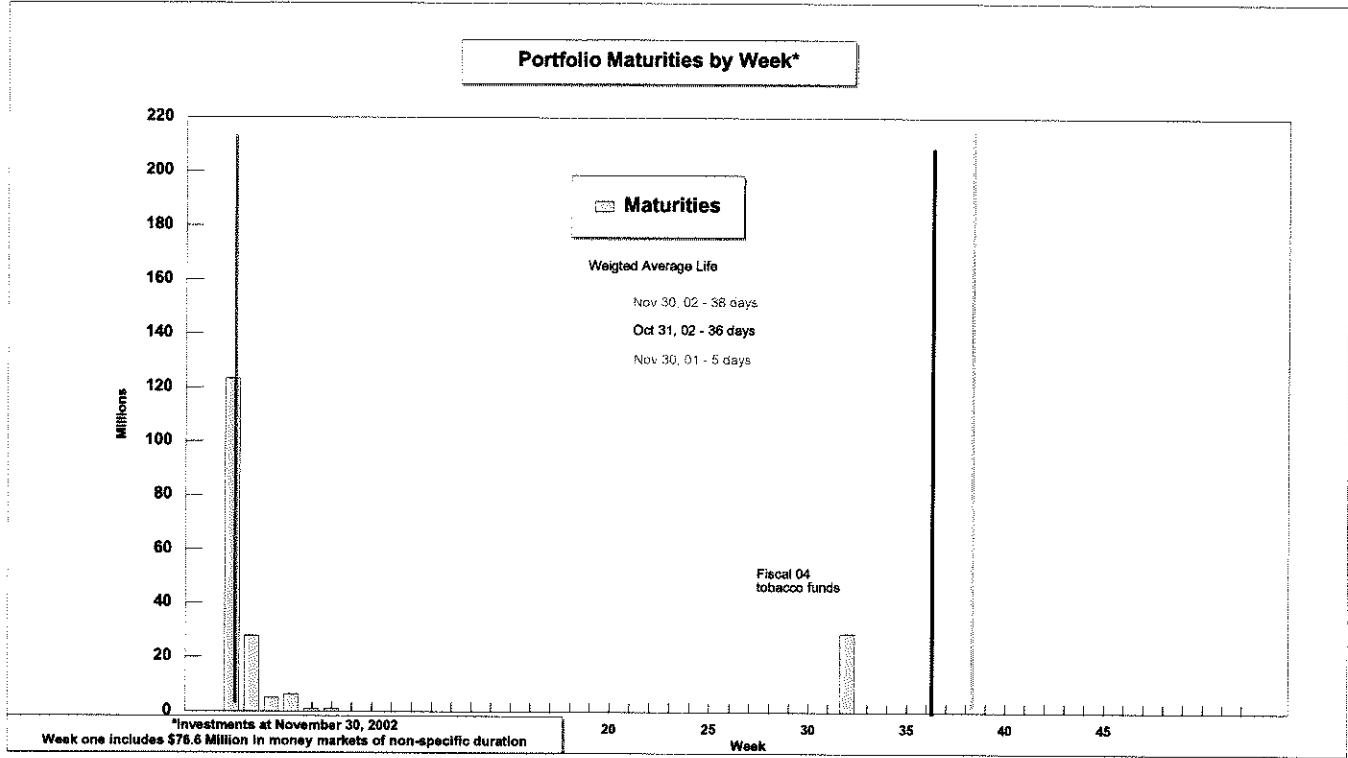
