

# **Investment Process Governance Consultant - Staff Recommendation**

February 2022

#### RECOMMENDATION

Engage Funston Advisory Services (FAS) to conduct a review of the Rhode Island State Investment Commission (SIC) policies and operations focusing on governance and investment process.

### **BACKGROUND AND SEARCH PROCESS**

The SIC authorized Staff to issue a request for proposal (RFP) for a consultant to review the governance around the State's investment process at the November 2021 meeting. Staff issued the RFP and received responses from five proposers.

The scope of work as described in the RFP was:

The SIC is looking for a firm to review and evaluate the following topics and identify opportunities for improvement:

- A. Investment governance structure
- B. By-laws, charters, and policies
- C. Commission meetings and operations
- D. Powers reserved for the Commission and delegations
- E. Reporting and Commission oversight
- F. Commission interactions with staff

Staff scored each proposal based on the following criteria:

- A. Organizational Characteristics
  - 1. Organization/staff expertise
  - 2. Depth of project team and resources
  - 3. Relevant prior experience
  - 4. References
- B. Benchmarking
  - 1. Ability to benchmark the SIC practices to appropriate peer organizations
  - 2. Knowledge of best practices
- C. Governance Review Process
  - 1. Proposed approach
  - 2. Project workplan
- D. Fees

Interviews were conducted with the top scoring proposers to further understand each firm's ability to conduct the review, ability to benchmark against relevant peers, and relevant experience in conducting similar projects. The proposal from Funston Advisory Services received the highest final score.

### **OVERVIEW**

Funston Advisory Services has provided governance reviews and advice since its inception in 2010. The firm has developed a number of proprietary tools that facilitate capturing opinions and data from key stakeholders (including all SIC members, key Staff members, and investment consultants) and benchmarking client practices relative to an appropriate peer set.

The initial phase of the project will include data gathering and relevant document review (the Investment Policy Statement, applicable Rhode Island code, etc.) plus peer comparisons on a number of relevant data points. The second phase will include input from key stakeholders and a self-assessment of current governance practices. The final phase is iterative and will include interviews with key stakeholders, ultimately concluding with a report and presentation to the SIC providing a set of recommendations and an implementation roadmap.

#### I. Peer Governance Benchmark

- FAS reviews SIC governance policies, charters and practices
- Treasury completes InGov® profile
- FAS develops and submits preliminary InGov® profile for review
- 4. InGov® report is finalized to incorporate Treasury feedback

# II. Governance Self-Assessment

- FAS customizes the 360 GEM™ Self-Assessment Survey
- 2. SIC and Treasury executives complete 360° GEM™ Self-Assessment Survey
- FAS analyzes policy assessment, InGov® profile, and 360 GEM™ results and prepares preliminary report
- 4. FAS reviews preliminary report with the CIO and refines

## III. Final Report and Roadmap

- 1. SIC reviews preliminary report
- 2. FAS conducts individual videoconference interviews with Commissioners, executives, and consultants
- 3. FAS revises and finalizes findings, conclusions and recommendations
- 4. FAS develops an implementation roadmap
- 5. FAS presents the final report and roadmap to the SIC
