Frank J. Karpinski Executive Director We write in response to your May 14, 2015 follow up inquiry of your April 28, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act

(APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response.

Could you please tell me how many members of the Providence Teacher's Union are having contributions sent to ERSRI? Put another way how many ACTIVE/Non retired people/members do you have on the books for Providence/Providence School Department.

There is no document responsive to your request. However, the number of employees under Providence School Department posted in the last payroll on April 26, 2015 was 1948; the number of employees under the 12 Month bi-weekly payroll on April 19, 2015 was 111. If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to RIGL §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Frank J. Karpinski, Executive Director of the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
