We write in response to your June 29, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response.

I am requesting the current list of Unclaimed Property held by Rhode Island, to include as much of the following detail as available: Owner name, reported address, holder name, unique property/file number, type of property, year reported, amount (exact or range), if possible.

There are no documents responsive to your request in the format requested. Pursuant to Rhode Island General Law §38-2-3(h), Treasury is not required to reorganize, consolidate, or compile data to fit the form requested. Additionally, production of such information in the format requested would be unduly burdensome for Treasury. If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Jeffrey M. Padwa, General Counsel for the Rhode Island General Treasurer's Office, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
