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This is to certify that .....

(a) A vote by written ballot was held on December 19, 1962 on the question of whether services of employees of the City of Warwick in positions covered by the Employees Retirement System of the State of Rhode Island should be included under the agreement entered into on December 20, 1951, by the State of Rhode Island and the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare pursuant to Section 218 of the Social Security Act;

(b) An opportunity to vote was given to all individuals who were members of the Employees Retirement System of the State of Rhode Island at the time the vote was held;

(c) Not less than ninety days notice of such vote was given to all individuals who were members of such system on the date the notice was issued;


