TO RHODE ISLAND STATE SOCIAL SECURITY AGREEMENT

The Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare, and the State of Rhode Island, acting through its representative designated to administer its responsibilities under the agreement of December 20, 1951, hereby accept as additional coverage groups under said agreement and acknowledge full applicability of the terms of said agreement to the following:

Services by individuals as employees of the following political subdivision of the State as members of coverage groups (as established by Section 218 (d) (4) of the Act) of the Retirement System designated as Part A of the Employees Retirement System of the State of Rhode Island (as established by Section 218 (d) (6) of the Act), including individuals in positions covered by the retirement system who are not members of the system but who are eligible to become members of such system.
