(a) A vote by written ballot was held on June 22, 1966 on the question of whether services of employees of the Town of Warren in positions covered by the Employees Retirement System of the State of Rhode Island should be included under the agreement entered into on December 20, 1951, by the State of Rhode Island and the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare pursuant to Section 218 of the Social Security Act;

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


