We requested the regional office to determine whether these employees are the only nonretirement system employees of the city and, if so, that the State be advised that the modification will cover all nonretirement system employees of the city. In a memorandum dated 11/22/57, the Regional Office reported that the State advised that the cafeteria employees are the only nonretirement system employees of the city and the State understands that all nonretirement system employees of the city are covered by this modification.
