SUBJECT: State and Local Coverage---Rhode Island Modifications
No. 87 and 88


Cleared for approval.

The intent of these Modifications is to implement section 141 of P.L. 92-603 to exclude certain student services and the services of certain employees in designated classes of part-time positions with respect to selected coverage groups.

The legal authority for effecting such exclusions is derived from a revision of the State enabling legislation, a copy of which revision is attached to each of the modifications. The said statutory revision follows exactly the suggested legislative change contained in our memorandum to Mr. Frank Nelen dated March 30, 1973 and we believe it provides sufficient legal authority to support the exclusions.

The language of the modifications follows the suggestions contained in Informational Release No. 9 of the Handbook with respect to selected coverage groups but also inadvertently contains in the second paragraph of each modification language appropriate for exclusions on a Statewide basis. To avoid any confusion in this regard, we understand Mr. Nelen will send you a telegram authorizing deletion of the language in the second paragraph of each modification.

We remind you that pursuant to Section 141 of Public Law 92-603, in order for these modifications to take effect on September 30, 1973 as specified, the modifications must be executed on or before June 30, 1973.

"...to amend such agreement effective after the effective date specified herein with respect to the following political subdivisions as listed in the attached appendix to this modification to exclude from coverage services performed in the employ of a school, college or university by a student or a student nurse who is enrolled and regularly attending classes at such school, college or university."
