

MODIFICATION NO. 62

TO RHODE ISLAND STATE SOCIAL SECURITY AGREEMENT

The Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare and the State of Rhode Island, acting through its representative designated to administer its responsibilities under the agreement of December 20, 1951, hereby accept as additional services under said agreement and acknowledge full applicability of the terms of said agreement to the following;

Services performed by individuals as employees of the State who are members of the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Rhode Island and whose positions had been included in that part of said retirement system composed of positions of members thereof who did not desire coverage under this agreement but who have filed a written request with the State of Rhode Island, pursuant to Section 218 (d) (6) (F) of the Act, that their positions be transferred to the part of said retirement system composed of the positions of the members thereof who desire coverage under this agreement including individuals deemed members of such system under Section 218 (d) (6) (E) of the Act.


