

COMMENTS:

Cleared for approval.

This is the first instance of coverage of Part A of the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island as it pertains to political subdivisions of the State. Authorization for such coverage under Federal and Rhode Island law and the Rhode Island agreement was discussed in our comments on Modification No. 29, which extended similar coverage to State employees.

"Optionals" are included pursuant to the 1958 Amendments to the Social Security Act and Chapter 62 of the Rhode Island Public Laws of 1959 (which was transmitted from the regional office to the central office on August 27, 1959).

This is also the first instance of retirement system coverage by Rhode Island after 1958. The State has submitted Modification No. 35, which would amend the body of the agreement to enable section 218(d)(8) coverage.

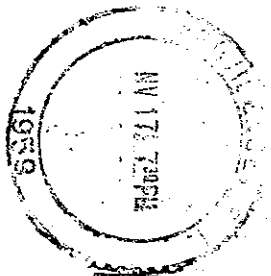
