We write in response to your April 10, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response:

The Dept of Revenue pays UTGR Inc. between \$6m to \$10m per month or so, what are these payments for?

There are no documents responsive to your request. Treasury does not oversee the information you seek. It is recommended that you direct your request to the Department of Revenue.

If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Jeffrey M. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
