


Summary of All Plans Data as of December 31, 2014








Summary of Defined Contribution Plan Data as of December 31, 2014







Plan assets By category class






Plan assets By category class






Participant Demographics Average asset balance by age group

Sharpe Ratio (Source: Morningstar Direct)

A risk-adjusted measure developed by Nobel Laureate William Sharpe. It is calculated by using standard deviation and excess return to determine reward per unit of risk. The higher the Sharpe Ratio, the better the portfolio's historical risk-adjusted performance. The Sharpe Ratio can be used to compare two portfolios directly with regard to how much excess return each portfolio achieved for a certain level of risk. Morningstar first calculates a monthly Sharpe Ratio and then annualizes it to put the number in a more useful one-year context.

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Standard Deviation (Source: Morningstar Direct) The statistical measurement of dispersion about an average, which depicts how widely a stock or portfolio's returns varied over a certain period of time. Investors use the standard deviation of historical performance to try to predict the range of returns that is most likely for a given investment. When a stock or portfolio has a high standard deviation, the predicted range of performance is wide, implying greater volatility.

Information Ratio (Source: Morningstar Direct) Benchmark Specific

Information ratio is a risk-adjusted performance measure. The information ratio is a special version of the Sharpe Ratio in that the benchmark doesn't have to be the risk-free rate.

Beta (Source: Morningstar Direct) Benchmark Specific

Beta is a measure of a portfolio's sensitivity to market movements. The beta of the market is 1.00 by definition.

Alpha (Source: Morningstar Direct) Benchmark Specific

A measure of the difference between a portfolio's actual returns and its expected performance, given its level of risk as measured by beta. A positive Alpha figure indicates the portfolio has performed better than its beta would predict. In contrast, a negative Alpha indicates the portfolio has underperformed, given the expectations established by beta.

Tracking Error (Source: Morningstar Direct) Benchmark Specific

Tracking error is a measure of the volatility of excess returns relative to a benchmark.

Upside (Source: Morningstar Direct) **Benchmark Specific**

Upside Capture Ratio measures a manager's performance in up markets relative to the market (benchmark) itself. It is calculated by taking the security's upside capture return and dividing it by the benchmark's upside capture return.

Downside (Source: Morningstar Direct) Benchmark Specific

Downside Capture Ratio measures a manager's performance in down markets relative to the market (benchmark) itself. It is calculated by taking the security's downside capture return and dividing it by the benchmark's downside capture return.

R-Square (Source: Morningstar Direct) Benchmark Specific

Reflects the percentage of a portfolio's movements that can be explained by movements in its benchmark.
