

We write in response to your December 2, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response.

Full repayment of principal

Did Governor Carcieri refuse to pay remainder of full principal? Yes/No

If yes, refused to pay remainder of full principal under what authority?

Has Governor Raimondo been presented with a request to make full payment on the outstanding principal from appropriate party? Yes/No

Was Governor Chafee presented with a request to make full payment on the outstanding principal for the appropriate party? Yes/No

The purpose of the Access to Public Records Act is to provide the public with access to public documents maintained by governmental agencies. It does not require agencies to respond to questions unless those questions can be answered by providing responsive Therefore, to fully comply with the APRA statute, and based on our understanding of your request, enclosed please find documents responsive to your request. Kindly note that documents responsive to request nos. 4 and 5 are the same.

If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to RIGL §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Frank J. Karpinski, Executive Director of the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
