We write in response to your June 2, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response.

I am requesting a copy of the lists of The State of Rhode Island's outstanding and stale dated checks. This request is made pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act.

Specifically, I am seeking records of outstanding and stale dated checks that were originally issued to companies, organizations and individuals by The State of Rhode Island. For each of these unnegotiated checks, I am requesting the name of the corporate vendor, organization or individual, the check number, the date of issue and dollar amount. I am interested in reviewing records of outstanding checks for all available years.

Enclosed please find a spreadsheet that details payees of outstanding checks for the last calendar year. Please note there is no one document maintained in the normal course of business that details unclaimed or outstanding checks for all available years. The list for the 2014 calendar year will be available after July 10, 2015.

If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Jeffrey M. Padwa, General Counsel for the Rhode Island General Treasurer's Office, 50 Service Avenue, 2nd Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also

file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
