We write in response to your January 30, 2015 request for information pursuant to the Rhode Island Access to Public Records Act (APRA). Your specific request is noted below along with our corresponding response.

I would like to make a Public Records request relating to calculating alternatives investment performance.

Forof the ERSRI's private alternatives investments, you please email to info@fundreil.com (or otherwise provide electronic access) either a .pdf or .xls file (whichever is easiest), with each entity on the same line/row in table format? Please include the most recent quarter-end that includes the following, in whichever order is most convenient or already available:

- 1. Partnership name;
- Fund Manager firm name ("regular" firm name you'd find on their website);
- 3. Sector focus, if applicable;
- 4. Year of initial pension investment (date is fine too);
- 5. Capital committed;
- 6. Since inception accumulated capital drawn;
- 7. Since inception accumulated distributions;
- 8. Most recent market value; and
- 9. Since inception/accumulated net IRR of the fund?

If you provide this information (or even more information) periodically to other Public Records requesters-in order to save you time, I'm sure those reports will do just fine for me too ... even if they include more information than requested above!

For clarity, "private alternatives" include:

- Private Equity funds;
- Venture Capital funds;
- Private equity-style **Real Estate** funds;
- Private equity-style Natural Resources and Other Real Assets funds;
- Private **Debt** and **Mezzanine** funds; and

## • Fund of Funds detail (the underlying funds' detail).

At this time, Treasury does not maintain one document responsive to your request in the normal course of its business. However, much of the information that you have requested is incorporated within the quarterly reports provided to the State Investment Commission (SIC). The SIC reports are accessible at <a href="http://treasury.ri.gov/treasury-divisions/investments-finance/state-investment-commission-reports/">http://treasury.ri.gov/treasury-divisions/investments-finance/state-investment-commission-reports/</a>.

If you contend you have been denied access to public records, pursuant to RIGL §38-2-8, you may appeal this decision to Frank J. Karpinski, Executive Director of the Employees' Retirement System of Rhode Island, 50 Service Avenue, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Warwick, RI 02886. You may also file a complaint with the Department of the Attorney General, 150 South Main Street, Providence, RI 02903 or the Rhode Island Superior Court of the county where the records are maintained.
